Our Cheltenham Residential Summer Centre is based at Cheltenham College, in Gloucestershire. This famous English boarding school is one of the most prestigious coeducational public schools in the country. #### Active English

#### Intensive English (with Trinity GESE exam)

### Meal plan




